

## “THE WRONG PRESCRIPTION”

### (Part 2)

#### JOHN 8:1-11

*We often unknowingly distort the facts as we process what we’re seeing through the limited scope of our own eyesight. In so doing, we create a situation where one should never have existed. The same can be true when we approach the Bible and misinterpret the Word of God and thus make it the word of man. We mishandle scripture and distort theology. We didn’t intend to but that’s exactly what happened.*

#### FAULTY SPIRITUAL ASSESSMENTS

- ① We more quickly see the \_\_\_\_\_ of others (8:3)
- ② We classify sin by \_\_\_\_\_ (8:4)
- ③ We \_\_\_\_\_ others’ sins harsher (8:5)
- ④ We hastily \_\_\_\_\_ others’ question (8:6)
- ⑤ We establish \_\_\_\_\_ at the base of the cross (8:7)

We do the same thing today as we judge a book by its cover and all-too-quickly assign a number less than ours to the person nearby.

You cannot be a \_\_\_\_\_ sinner than another sinner.

- ⑥ We neglect \_\_\_\_\_ (8:8-9)

For starters, are you even a \_\_\_\_\_ (2 Cor. 13:5)?

Beyond salvation, there is the continual need of examining your \_\_\_\_\_ – your spiritual growth (Psalm 139:23-24).

- ⑦ We minimize \_\_\_\_\_ (8:10,11b)

Sin displeases God, falls short of His glory, and needs confession and cleansing. Failure to do so will hinder your connection with Christ and sidetrack your journey with Jesus.

Not only do we minimize the need of forgiveness from God, we can choose to \_\_\_\_\_ it toward others.

- ⑧ We offer \_\_\_\_\_ for sin (8:11a)

Jesus Himself doesn’t discount her offense when He instructs her to go and sin no more. He calls it sin and offers forgiveness.

Sin is a problem. Thankfully, the sinless Savior came to a sin-fallen world and offered up His life. All because of GRACE!
