CONCLUSION

Everything's coming up roses for the Israelites. They've been liberated from Egypt with God leading their way. But a few days into their journey, they arrive at a crossroads. The desert and water surround them. Adding to their dilemma is what they see when they look back toward Egypt: Pharaoh and his army fast approaching them. How will these followers of God respond?

Initially, they \underline{f} with God and ponder \underline{f} from Him and back into the hands of their antagonist. But having regained their attention, God gives the Israelites an opportunity to walk by \underline{f} . If they will reinsert Him into their picture, they can do just that! With God behind them and the water before them, they head into the sea. By faith, they take God at His word and press on in obedience.

It all comes together here – fight, flee and faith! The Israelites have <u>f</u>_____, so they need not flee or fight. The Egyptians have no <u>f</u>_____, and no <u>f</u>____, so they can only but flee. You can trust Him. So when the next threat comes your way, you have three options:

- 1) <u>A</u> \rightarrow take things into your own hands and fight
- 2) <u>A</u> \rightarrow take things into your own hands and flee
- 3) <u>A</u> \rightarrow entrust yourself to the Lord and walk in faith
