

## “YOU SAY YOU BELIEVE?”

### JOHN 4:43-54

*Everyone has faith. You wake up in the morning and put your feet on the floor. That takes faith to now stand up. You turn the water on in the shower. That takes faith to let it cover your body. You insert the key to turn on the engine of your car. That too takes faith that it will start. But what exactly is the object of your faith? Who or what are you ultimately trusting in?*

### WHICH TYPE OF FAITH DO YOU HAVE?

① A Faith in \_\_\_\_\_ (4:46-50)

His response (4:49) evidences this type of faith:

1. “Sir” ≠ Jesus is \_\_\_\_\_.
2. “Come down” ≠ Jesus is all-\_\_\_\_\_.

### CONCLUSION

Don’t overlook the greater miracle here. This healing, in and of itself, is amazing! It’s a miracle. But sometime in the future, this son who was raised from that sickness leading to death will eventually die.

Ten out of every ten people will die. That’s why the greatest miracle here isn’t the healing but something else. It’s what changed this man and his entire family.

Without faith, it is impossible to please God. So you want to make sure you have faith, the right kind of faith that pleases Him.
